



## Comhairle Lucht Féachana TG4 2025: Ballraíocht

Déanadh na folúntais don Chomhairle Lucht Féachana nua a fhógairt le linn Earrach 2025. Roghnaíodh baill don chomhairle nua le bheith *ionadaitheach ar an phobal féachana agus éisteachta agus, go háirithe, ar phobal Ghaeltachta.*

Leanfaidh an tréimhse ballraíochta reatha ó 2025 go dtí go bhfuil athruithe san Acht Craolacháin curtha i bhfeidhm.

Is iad seo a leanas na Baill den Chomhairle nua:

### Ógie Ó Céilleachair: An Rinn

Is as Rinn Ó gCuanach d'Ógie Ó Céilleachair. Múinteoir meánscoile é i nGaelcholáiste Luimnígh, é ag teagasc Staire, Gaeilge, an Pholaitíocht & an tSochaí agus Drámaíocht. Tá téascleabhar staire don Teastas Sóisearach, mar a bhí, foilsithe aige chomh maith the trí leabhar ficsin; Cúpla, Katfish & Scéalta Eile agus Árasán. Tá úrscéal agus gearrscéalta dá chuid ar an liosta molta don tSraith Shóisearach Gaeilge. Is teagascóir é i gColáiste Mhuire gan Smál i Luimneach leis.

### Aoife Ní Dhonaile, Baile Átha Cliath

Is aturnae faoi oliúint as Baile Átha Cliath í Aoife, agus tá an Ghaeilge mar chuid lárnach dá h'obair dheonach. Is bunaitheoir agus cathaoirleach í ar Chraobh Chonradh na Gaeilge Baile Átha Cliath 7. Mar cheannaire ar an ghrúpa comhphobal seo, spreagann sé í chun an teanga a chaomhnú i ngach slí. Tá spéis faoi leith aici in ábhar TG4 ar líne, ceol Gaelach agus ábhar dírithe ar an aos óg.

### Colm Ó Baoill, Gaoth Dobhair.

Rugadh agus tógaigh Colm i nGaoth Dobhair. Tá sé ag obair sa rannóg Pobal & Gnó le Foras na Gaeilge. Tá sé ar choiste stiúrtha Chomhar Chreidmheasa Gaoth Dobhair agus Comharchumann Forbartha Gaoth Dobhair. Tá suim aige i gcúrsaí Pleanála Teanga agus forbartha pobail. Nuair a bhíonn am saor aige, is maith leis seoltóireacht nó ag siúl sna cnoic.

### Siobhán Níc an Lia, An Fhód Dhubh (Maigh Eo)

Tá Siobhán lonnaithe san Fhód Dubh, Co. Mhaigh Eo. Oibríonn sí mar Oifigeach Forbartha d'lorras agus d'Acaill le Tuismitheoirí na Gaeltachta. Is breá leí fuайл, shiúlóidí dúlra agus am lena teaghlaigh agus lenár gcairde. Tá suim aici i gcláir céasair reatha agus cláir faisnéise. **Joe Seoighe**, Conamara.

**Aoife Ní Bhraoin**, Luimneach

Is as Cathair Luimnigh d'Aoife. Oibríonn sí mar aistritheoir agus iriseoir le ExtraG.ie. Ghlac sí páirt sa Dianchúrsa Oiliúna san Iriseoireacht le déanaí. Tá suim aici i gcúrsaí amharclannaíochta agus siamsaíochta, spórt, cúrsaí polaitíochta, agus go leor eile!

**Katie Bán Breathnach**, Conamara

Rugadh agus tógadh Katie in Indreabhán, agus tá clann óg á thógáil aici ina ceantar dúchais. Is múinteoir bunscoile í le breis agus cúig bliana déag, agus tá sí gníomhach i gcúrsaí pobail agus cultúir sa cheantar. Tá taithí aici ar obair le daoine ó gach aoisghrúpa idir pháistí, déagóirí, tuismitheoirí, foghlameoirí agus an pobal i gcoitinne. Tá suim mhór aici sa spóirt, agus in ábhar clár don óige.

**Labhaoise Ní Dhonncadha**, Gaillimh

**Caitríona Buidhléir**, Corca Dhuibhne

Is ó Bhaile an Fheirtéaraigh, Corca Dhuibhne í Caitríona. Is as Rathcairn i gCondae na Mí é Éamonn, agus é ag tógáil clainne le Gaeilge ansin. Is ceoltóir é agus gníomhaí pobail sa Ghaeltacht.

Tá sí ag obair mar léiritheoir le breis is 25 bliain agus tá réimse leathan cláir léirithe aici idir cláir Faisnéise, Siamsaíochta agus Drámaíochta. Tá taithí aici ag léiriú clár do chraoltóirí mar TG4, RTE, BBC agus do chraoltóirí go h-idirnáisiúnta mar Discovery agus Arte. Tá sí mar bhall giúré Idirnáisiúnta ar Fhéile na Meán Cheilteach.
